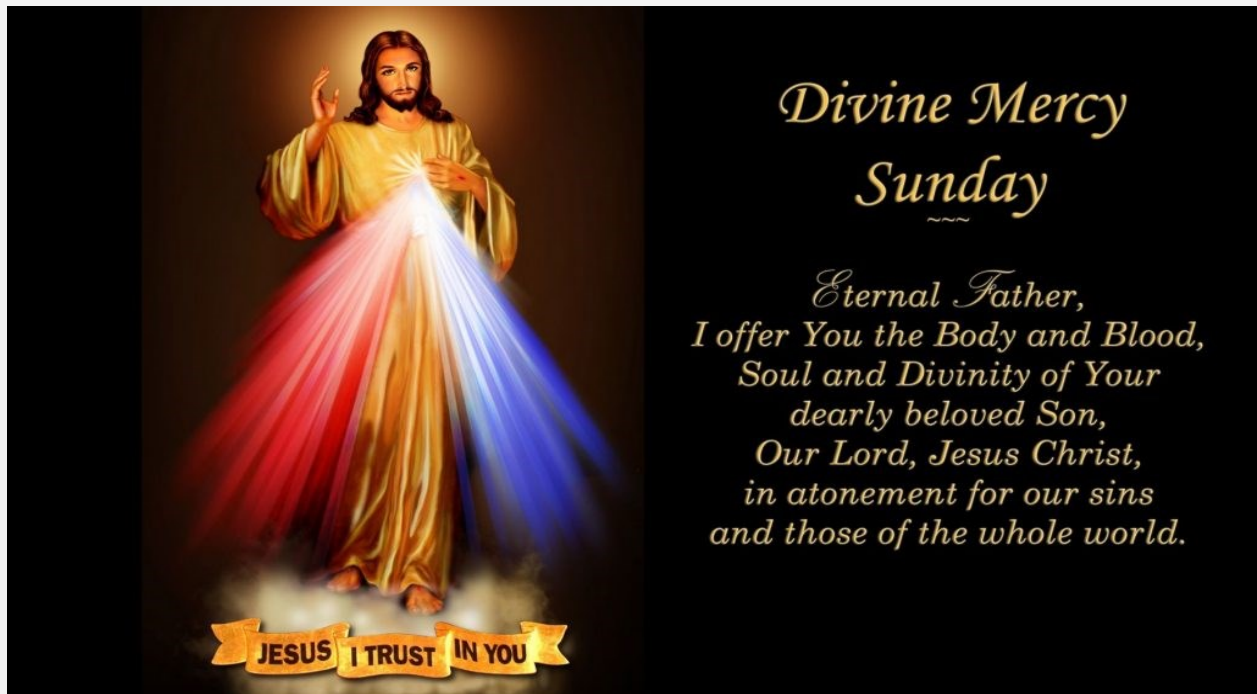

Please come pray for priests and vocations and hear how God called Fr. Broudou to the priesthood. Fr. Joseph Broudou is from Mauritius, which is 500 miles off the East coast of Madagascar. He is of French, African, Indian, and Asian origin and speaks four other languages. French, English, Creole and Spanish. Born on August 9, 1963, he is the third of six children.

Most of his relatives live in Australia.

Fr. Broudou was ordained for the Archdiocese of Omaha on June 1, 1996. He received his education, lived and served in many places, including Singapore, Ohio, Colorado, Illinois, Wisconsin, and Nebraska. Since he has lived at nearly thirty addresses since his birth he refers to himself as a 'roaming Catholic'.

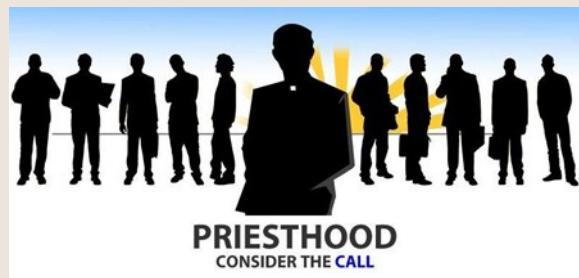
