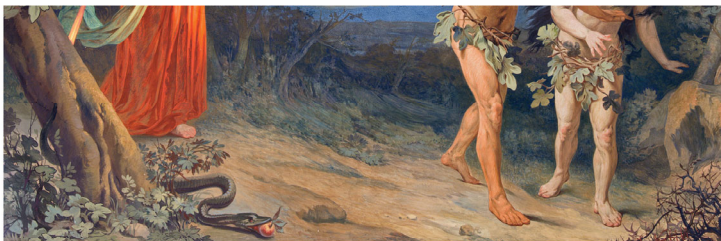
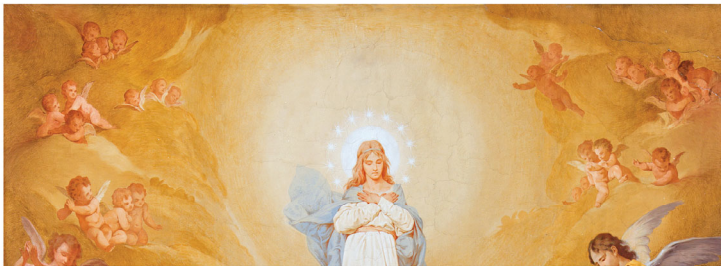

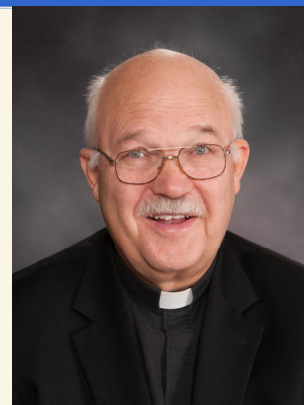

Minh will shadow me in my priestly duties and get involved in parish activities as much as possible. I look forward to getting to know Minh and I am confident that St. Bernadette Parish will provide a warm welcome for him.

I am Minh Tran. I have three brothers and three sisters, all of them are married. I am the second in seven of them. My father died and my mother is living in Vietnam.

When I was 14 years old, I would like be a priest because my parish priest is a model for my dream. When I was 21 years old, I finished high school. So I got into the vocational school of statistics and accounting for 4 years to pursuit the accountancy. I graduated this school when I was 25 years old. I worked in the Ajinomoto factory at my hometown for 6 years to help my family. Thank be to God all of my 5 siblings finished high school and they have the job now.

In 2006, I changed another company because I would like to study more. I work in the Viet Ha Commercial Services Export- Import Co. LTD, in the big city (Ho Chi Minh City). I work part-time and study to get bachelor of accounting and study at PAUL NGUYEN VAN BINH Institute of Theology because I would like to understand more about God Whom I love so much.

After many years working and study in Institute of Theology I decided to follow Jesus. I came to Philippines on the September 7th, 2009 for postulancy of the Order of the Holy Cross and after that the Order sent me to Brazil in 2010 for novitiate and study Philosophy and Theology. I left the Order of the Holy Cross because I would like be a parish priest. I went to USA in February 26, 2015.

I was nourished in a traditional Catholic home. I was an altar boy for many years. This time make me have a desire be a priest. When I finished high school, with the guidance of my dad I study accounting, after that I have a good job and help my siblings continue to go to school. The time makes me forget my desire be a priest because I have girlfriend. When everything would seem good, my lover wants me to marry but I promise her to wait a little time. At the same time, in my heart, there is something that made me to search my desire. I met my spiritual father; he helps me to recognize the call of God. I pray and pray with longing to find exactly if I have vocation or not, especially I pray with St. Joseph and Mother Mary to assist me to understand the meaning of serve God in the life of celibacy. One day, I feel in my heart the happiness throughout the Word of God: "if anyone wants to come with me, he must forget self, carry his cross, and follow me" (Mt 16, 24).

Day by day, I recognize the call of God clearer in my heart, I want to be a servant of God. This is a reason I must choose between my job, my lover and my vocation. I experienced with the challenge between the marriage and celibate. This is the most importance in my life, up to now I am happy because I chose the right way that I am eager to live for Jesus and for his work.

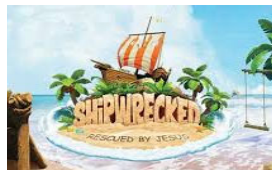
