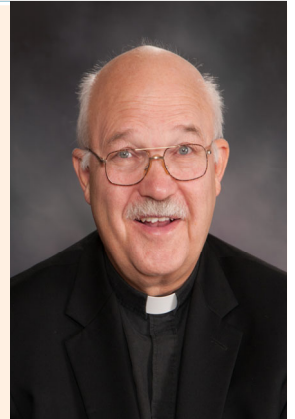

40th Jubilee of Priesthood

Thank you to all who have come to celebrate my 40th anniversary with me this weekend. I welcome family, friends and past parishioners who have come to St. Bernadette today. I look forward to greeting all of you, as you have played a significant part in my priestly life and have supported me through encouragement and prayer over the years.

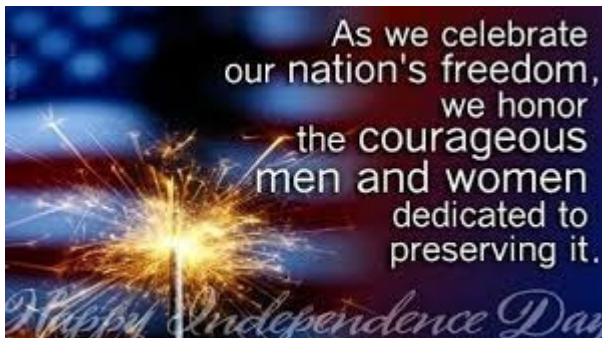
