## Fr. Harry's Buseness

Now that we are in August, people are beginning to look toward the new school year. Our elementary and high schools will be opening in a couple of weeks. Our recent high school graduates will be heading off to college soon. And this time of year prompts some people to look at their own formation including faith formation.

I am pleased to introduce a new evangelization and faith formation effort beginning at St. Bernadette parish this year – ChristLife. We are embarking on this initiative in conjunction with the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis of the Archdiocese. ChristLife is an evangelization process that makes missionary disciples by helping people to encounter Jesus Christ personally, follow him as Catholic disciples, and share him with others. Our participation in this effort is also an expression of involvement in Archbishop Lucas' vision for the archdiocese: **"One Church, encountering Jesus, equipping disciples, living mercy."**

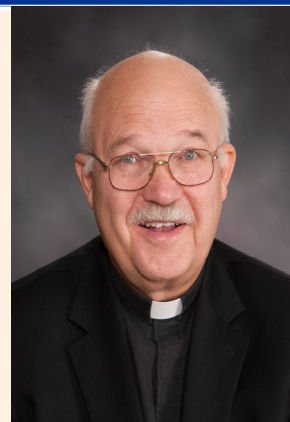
ChristLife's vision is "to equip Catholics for the essential work of evangelization so that others might come to know personally the love of God through Jesus Christ, in the Holy Spirit, becoming His followers and members of the Church."

Really, the objective of ChristLife is to draw people into a deeper and more personal relationship with Jesus Christ and to enable those deeply committed Catholics to share that faith with others. This dynamic is greatly needed in our time when so many people abandon their faith at some point in their adult lives.

The ChristLife process includes three seven-week courses: Discovering Christ, Following Christ, and Sharing Christ. These will be offered here at St Bernadette during fall 2017, winter 2018 and spring 2018. The first session primarily targets people who are likely to be formation leaders for subsequent sessions. We will be ready for the general parish population to participate in the session beginning after the first of the year. It will be the only adult faith formation effort at St. Bernadette for the coming year.
