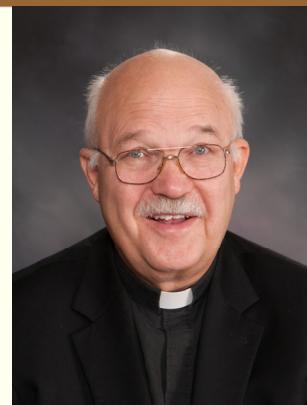

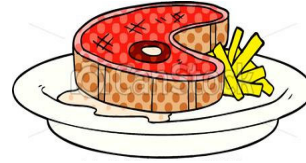

RCIA Study Program

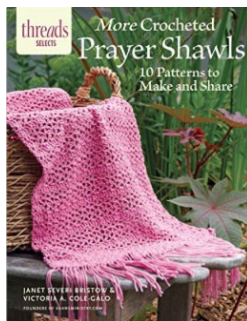
- Are you an adult interested in becoming a Catholic or in learning more about the Catholic Faith?
