From the Pastors Desk

I would like to thank everyone for their generosity in helping fund our new sign, we hit our goal and any extra money we will use for upcoming projects. We are waiting to get an electrical issue resolved, and then we should have the sign up and running. We have two other projects that we are currently working on. The first is to update technology, computers, and internet security at the parish office. We are working with the Archdiocese of Omaha's IT Department to get our parish offices up to the standard required for cyber security insurance, and to make sure that we have what we have the hardware, software, and support we need to function. These upgrades will also allow us to work more efficiently with 2 parish office sites, here and Holy Ghost. Perhaps on a more exciting note, we also have a committee beginning the process of coming up with a plan to renovate our church interior. We need some cosmetic upgrades and a new sound system. We are still in the beginning phases of this project, but we hope to be able to share some of the ideas with the parish very soon.

We are now just 4 weeks away from merging with Holy Ghost parish and implementing our new Sunday and weekday Mass schedule. This is coming up fast and will represent a major shift in how our parish functions. Please continue to pray our new parish family.

This Sunday we are hosting the Home & School Vendor Blender in our parish cafeteria from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM. Stop by to check out local crafts, food, and other neat items and support our Home & School families.
