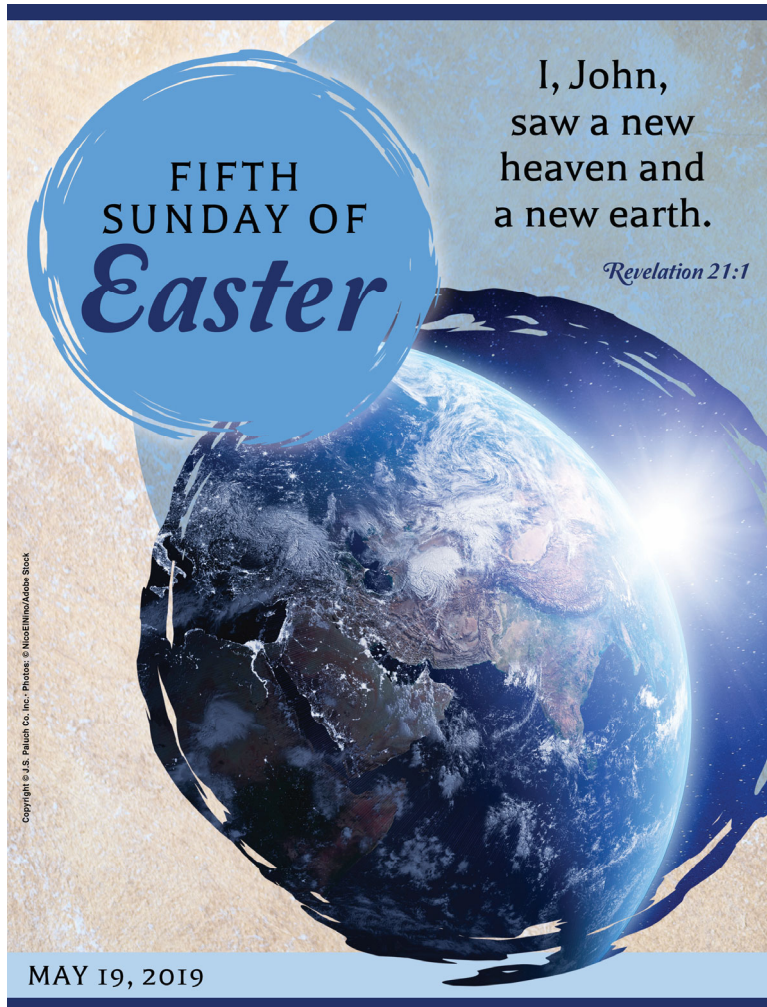

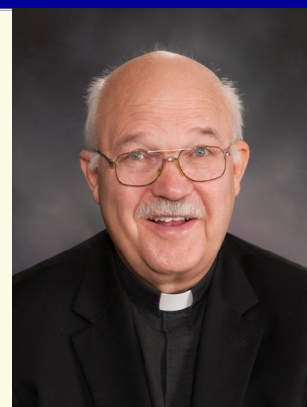

2019 Vacation Bible School...ROAR!!!!

Due to the construction being done in the social hall this year, we've had to make some changes. Please read this thoroughly.

When: June 17-21st

Time: 9am- 12 (noon)

Where: Opening and Closing will be upstairs in the church.

No one can be dropped off any earlier than 8:40am (there is 8am daily mass). Drop off is to be from the UPPER LOT. The horse shoe drive will be blocked off, so parents need to park in the upper lot and then walk their child(ren) into the church. On Monday, 6/17, check in will be right outside the church doors. Daily closing will also be in the church so please use only the upper lot for pick up as well. No one will be allowed to park or pick up from the horse shoe drive (safety first).
