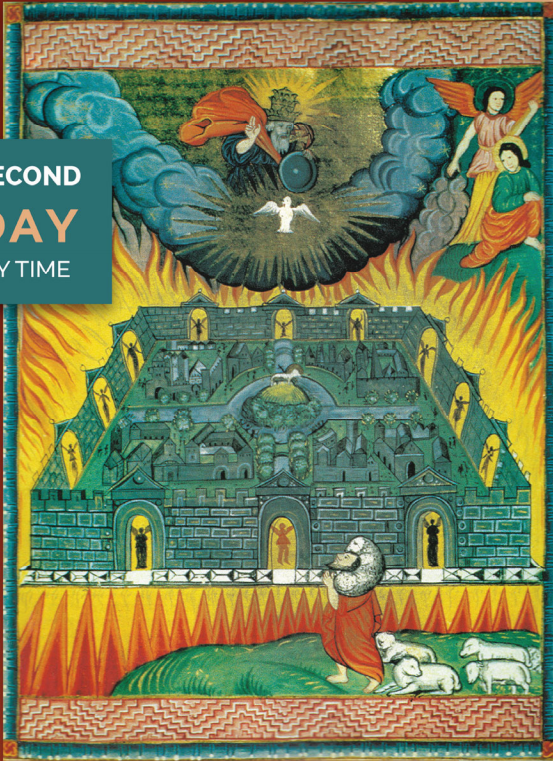

A Note From The Pastor

This weekend we hear about the importance of humility. St. Augustine says that humility is the foundation of all the other virtues. Humility is the virtue by which a Christian acknowledges that God is the author of all good. Humility avoids inordinate ambition or pride, and provides the foundation for turning to God in prayer

A few weeks ago, I held some informational meetings about our new parish family, I mentioned the Archdiocesan “big goal” for all the parishes of the Archdiocese to become missional communities. One of the ways that we are working to achieve that goal is with our Family of Faith program that we started a few years. Most of this program focuses on the families of the students who are enrolled in our religious ed program. This year we are going expand parts of this program to the whole parish, by inviting everyone to come to our parent classes. This year we are going to focus on prayer; how we pray as a church, how can we deepen our prayer as individuals, and learning about different types of prayer.

We are also busy preparing to begin Alpha with Holy Ghost parish. Alpha is an 11-week program that is designed to help people explore the very definition of what it means to call ourselves Christian. This program is run in parishes all over the Archdiocese of Omaha and we are excited to bring these opportunities to our new parish family. You will hear more about these opportunities in the bulletin and at Mass.
