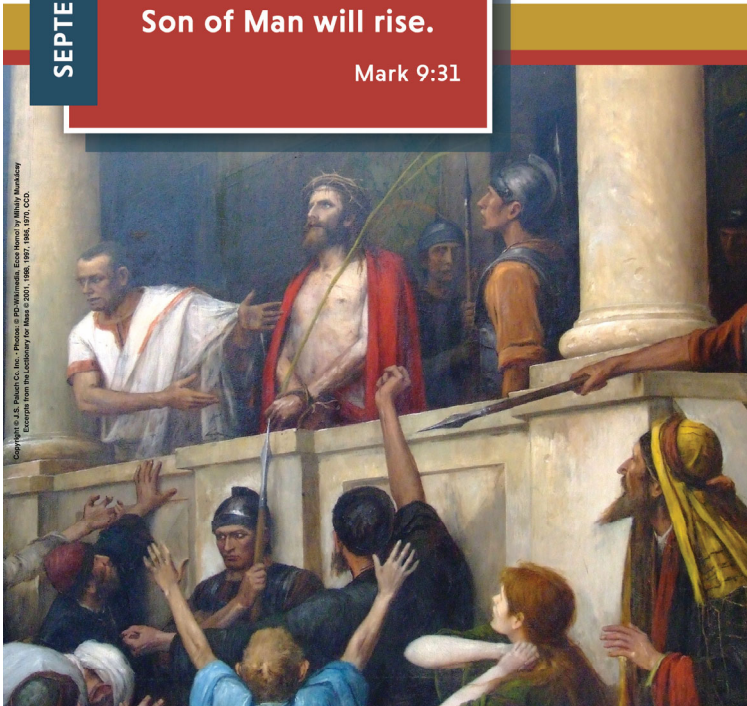

Feast of St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist –
Tuesday, September 21st

If you have not yet signed on to FORMED, here's another great opportunity to give it a try.

This Tuesday, 9/21, is the Feast Day of St. Matthew, Disciple and Chosen Apostle, Evangelist and Gospel Writer. Logon to the FORMED website and watch a video on this amazing disciple of Christ, called personally by Jesus and transformed from hated tax collector to beloved apostle.

May I suggest two videos on Matthew. Once you are logged in to FORMED, simply use the search box to find the following videos.

The first is a very short 7 minute video, "**The Calling of Matthew**", which has great insight into an artwork depicting this moment where is called by Jesus.

The second is a 30 minute video, "**Feast of St. Matthew**", which delves into the writer of the 'first' version of the gospel. His is a gospel of fulfillment, where the life of Jesus fulfills the writings of the Old Testament.

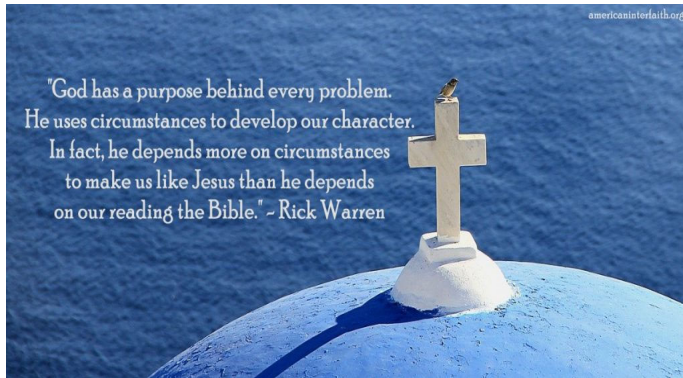

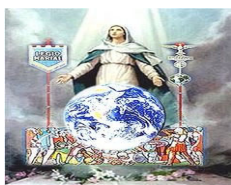

Four Main Vocations (In a series 3 of 4) The Catholic Church recognizes four main vocations: Priesthood, Religious Life, Marriage, and Single Life. In each vocation, the person lives a life of faith and prayer to continually grow in relationship with God. He calls everyone to follow Him. Here is a brief outline of the four vocations: Marriage – A married person lives a vow of faithful love to a spouse through the sacrament of marriage. Husbands and wives share a self-giving, love-giving and life-giving relationship with their spouse, and are committed to helping their spouse grow to human and Christian maturity. They seek to form a family home, and are together the first teachers of their children in Christian faith and values. Married people may serve in their parish community or in the Church in a number of different ways.
