## From the Pastor



As you may remember back in 2020, Archbishop Lucas requested that every parish in the archdiocese should make a conscientious effort in becoming missional communities by 2026. What does this mean? To be a missional parish family, means that the community is committed to shifting their priorities and influence toward the mission of making disciples and witnessing to the Gospel to the people in their lives; much of what I preached about last week.

I am privileged to continue what Fr. Buse began and Fr. Mollner fostered here at Bernadette and Holy Ghost. Working with a dedicated Faith Formation team led by Deacon Subby is very encouraging as we move forward in implementing our clear path of discipleship for our parish family. Essentially the clear path of discipleship is the strategic plan of implementing the parishes evangelization efforts. In other words, it's the plan of how we are making disciples and preaching the Gospel.

I am so excited at what the Lord is doing and will do in our community. Recently we have invited parishioners to receive a 6-week training called "Reach One More" that teaches participants how to evangelize others. Due to the hard work of our teams, 55 people from Holy Ghost and Bernadette said yes to attending the training! Indeed, what the Lord said is true, "the harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so, ask the Master of the harvest to send our laborers for His harvest." If you were unable to attend or were not initially invited, don't worry. This is only the first of many times that we will offer this opportunity.

A big part of the clear path of discipleship is something called a conversion engine. A conversion engine is the primary event people can be invited to, to hear the gospel and encounter Jesus Christ, sometimes ever for the first time. I am excited to report that we are putting great efforts into offering our conversion engine "Alpha" twice a year, under the leadership of Deacons Al and Tom. The next Alpha will begin on September 16th . In today's first reading, Jeremiah tells us that the Lord says, "I myself will gather the remnant of my flock from all the lands. . . and bring them back to their meadow. " I truly believe this is what the Lord is doing here at Bernadette/Holy Ghost. That "His heart is moved with pity" for so many in our families and neighborhoods who are scattered and so hungry for His love and mercy because "they are like sheep without a shepherd." Let us pray for those in our lives who do not know Him that they will encounter Him; for those who have strayed away from Him that they will return; for us who follow Him that we may work together in the Father's vineyard in bringing these souls to closer to Him.
