

St. Bernadette Church Renovation Update Our Faith, Our Family, Our Future

- As you all know, the capital campaign was successful and pledge donations are coming into the parish.
- If you have any problems with your pledge donations or have not started them, please contact the parish office.
- We had a brief delay in finalizing the plans with Fr. Mollner leaving and the transition to Fr. Boyd.
- Fr. Boyd has met with the architects at Carlson West Povondra and they are currently finalizing the detailed construction plans for the project. Previously, we had concept design and renderings only that are not detailed enough for bidding and construction.
- A couple minor changes have been made to the design; more tile
 will be installed in the altar and other areas, and the choir loft will
 be renovated to accommodate all liturgical music so we do not lose
 any pew seating in the church.
- Once the construction plans are complete, we will send the plans out for bids and hire a general contractor to run the project.
- We still anticipate starting construction in 2024.






