


Campaign Corner: Campaign Kick Off

What will be included in the church renovations?

Our church is where we come together to worship, gather around the table for the Eucharist and share our faith. It is a sacred space that holds some of the most important rituals of our lives and nurtures our relationships with God and with each other.

It is due time for some updates that will allow the sanctuary to better reflect the family of faith we already are. Our plan is to:

- Enhance the overall acoustics in the church. This was the top priority identified during our recent planning study.
- Center the tabernacle behind the altar and install a new quartz top on the existing altar.
- Add pendant lighting over the sanctuary.
- Create distinguished choir and candle areas on either side of the sanctuary. This will remedy the problem of smoke from the candles staining the walls and create a distinct prayer space.
- Add another alcove in the back of church for a statue of St. Bernadette.
- Replace carpet throughout the church and the tile around the baptismal font.
- Refinish the pews.
- Brighten and warm the church with a fresh coat of paint.
- Install a motorized screen and projector.
